Memorial Scholarship

A scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 will be awarded to a student who is attending college as an undergraduate or graduate student. A member who requests an application must be in the Auxiliary for two (2) years and in good standing. Children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, and nieces/nephews are eligible. The applicants do not need to be a resident of this state. All completed applications must be received by the scholarship committee, by April 30th.

The scholarship will be awarded at the June Scholarship Banquet.

It is the intention of the Committee to award to a recipient a scholarship that is based primarily on academic achievement, civic contribution and some financial need. Please read the following questions carefully. Direct your answers to the priorities mentioned. All applications will remain confidential.

UNDERGRADUATES must be working on their first Bachelor's Degree and maintain a GPA of at least 2.5. The applicant must be 25 years old or younger and enrolled full time taking at least 9 credits.

GRADUATE students must be full time, preferably under the age of 30 (exceptions will be considered only with an in-depth explanation). Must NOT have employer reimbursement and need to maintain a GPA of 3.0. We will need proof of registration. Their essay should include the reason why they are in Grad school.
