## Mary Bogino Scholarship

Mary Bogino was born in Italy and came to Connecticut when she was 10 years old. She was a founding member of the Women's Auxiliary of the Prince Thomas of Savoy Italian Club and served as its Treasurer for over 25 years. This scholarship is named for her and in honor of her importance and dedication to the Club.

A scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 will be awarded to a student who will graduate from high school in June and will attend a college or junior college in the fall. A member who requests an application must be in the Auxiliary for two (2) years and in good standing. Children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, and nieces/nephews are eligible. The applicants do not need to be a resident of this state. All completed applications must be received by the scholarship committee, by April 30th.

The scholarship will be awarded at the June Scholarship Banquet.

It is the intention of the Committee to award to a recipient a scholarship that is based primarily on academic achievement, civic contribution and some financial need. Please read the following questions carefully. Direct your answers to the priorities mentioned. All applications will remain confidential.
